OUR MISSION

Simply stated our mission is to transition a community of up to 29 veterans suffering from homelessness back into society as self-supporting productive members within a two to three-year time frame.

Veterans Village is not a homeless shelter. It is a safe, secure community where resident veterans receive all the services (medical care, social skills, job skills, etc.) needed so that they can reintegrate back into

WHAT WE'VE ACCOMPLISHED WITH YOUR HELP IN 2025

- Twenty-nine tiny homes were constructed in Veterans Village.
- A robust security system including cameras and access control was installed and are operational.
- The Community Center was completed which includes a computer center, kitchen, an Honor Pantry, administrative offices and a gathering room.
- The first 18 veterans were interviewed, screened and are in residence.
- Full time employees were hired.
- Relationship with community advocacy groups, civic organizations, volunteer groups and churches were created and which help to serve our veterans.

HOW YOUR SUPPORT MAKES A DIFFERENCE



- Help fund essential medical services (physical and mental).
- Provide regular maintenance to all our homes and facilities.
- Maintain the integrity of the village property.

- The opportunity to hire staff to serve the veterans needs.

OUR GOALS FOR 2026

- As of the beginning of December we have 18 resident veterans. During the next year our objective is to increase that number to 29 residents.
- Complete remaining village irrigation, landscaping, and the Hope Garden
- .- Work with the city of Brunswick and provide the funds needed to address parking needs.
- Continue veteran outreach and host veteran events.
- Work with local companies and organizations to assist our veterans to find gainful employment, job skill training, and identify educational opportunities.
- Continue to raise funds to sustain our operational health.
